## **Unfinished Business and Reports**

- A. Casey Special Use Permit. Craig Meredith spoke with Sam Johnson of the ATF about the permit; Shelley to contact Dave Casey for original application.
- <u>B. Campground.</u> Craig said Mr. Childs is preparing the packets and said projects like this can sometimes take many months.
- C. Anderson Property. It was agreed to await Mark Eidelson's opinion.
- D. Mobile Home Replacement Amendment. Tabled.
- E. Blighted Properties. No action at this time by the JPC.
- <u>F. Eugene Allen Position.</u> Gene will continue to serve as a member of the JPC; there is no legal conflict as Sue reported in April.
- <u>G. Capital Improvements Plan.</u> Data was distributed. Committee will meet to work on preparing a master document. Peggy suggested adding the final version to Colfax's website. Craig reported that at the last Road Commission meeting it was not known if there would be funding for Black Bridge but they keep trying.
- <u>H. Community Action Report.</u> Peggy prepared and reviewed a summary of the Sarah Lucas housing presentation. Numerous options were discussed that could be explored including future speakers on property development. Don expressed concern on what the area offers and asked if it would it be better to focus on industry and jobs. Revisit to set date/time when speakers are available.

The JPC reviewed the ordinance and agreed the high density R-3 district did not permit chickens. Shelley will notify Mrs. Bissell.

<u>C. Planning & Zoning News.</u> Shelley only recently noticed on the form that debit and credit cards are not accepted, only checks, and will request a check for \$360 for 13 subscriptions.
