Unfinished Business:

Police Contract: noted that liquor license inspections were taking place by the officer we contracted to provide coverage for the area. Evitts discussed this with the Sheriff Dept to state we do not want these inspections conducted during our contracted hours. Sheriff Heckman assures it will not happen again. 25 tickets have been issues during contract period thus far.

Blight Ordinance: Evitts suggests this be set aside for the time being; discussed with prosecuting attorney and he will not prosecute. Discussion to bring up in future, as any ordinance we put in place would still require an enforcer which we do not have, and this may be something that could tie in with JPC. Also stated winter will be hitting by time we have

anything set up, making useless until spring, when JPC and zoning will be better defined. All agreed.

Budget Review: Discussion, Mosher to bring updated budget to next meeting with recommended adjustments.

Pay Bills: Motion by Evitts, 2nd by Skurski to pay as presented. No opposition, motion carries.
